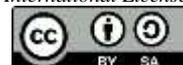

In fact, the world of education is a world that is never empty of academic criticism and debate, in fact educational problems have never been resolved throughout the history of human life (Ashtari et al., 2020). This is because one of the unique qualities of humans when compared to the lives of other creatures, is that they are never devoid of the noble values they aspire to (Zangiacoimi et al., 2020). Islam as a religion places education in a very important position. (Anggraini, 2019)

To solve problems that arise from various fields certainly requires strategy (Crețan et al., 2023). The education sector is seen as the most potential to instill the values of togetherness, unity, and closeness between ethnic, racial, religious and cultural diversity (Alberti et al., 2019). This is as stated in the law of the Republic of Indonesia No. 20 of 2003 concerning

National education:

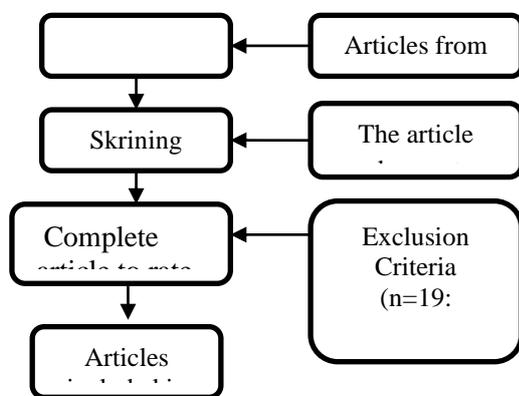
